Dear members:

More money is needed if we are to complete the summer tests of the waters of Ten Mile Lake. In the July newsletter, along with the annual \$10 membership fee, we asked for an additional contribution of at least \$15 per member. With two-thirds of the returns now in, we are averaging under \$11 per contribution.

This income will not entirely pay for the testing project, whose total cost will be \$10,311. The officers and directors feel the completion of this project is important. It will show the relative effect on water quality of people (septic drainage) and nature (drainage into the lake from snow melt and hard rains). The data will provide a gauge by which we can make spot checks in future years at costs we anticipate will be within the annual budget.

But this year we need a better response if we are to finish the work of biologist Del Hogen of Instrumental Research, Inc.

If you haven't responded to the dues notice and special contribution, please do so today. Send more than the \$15 contribution if possible. Besides the testing project, we have to keep up newsletters, print a directory in 1983, and take care of routine expenses.
